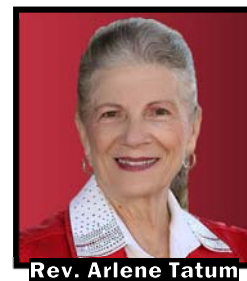

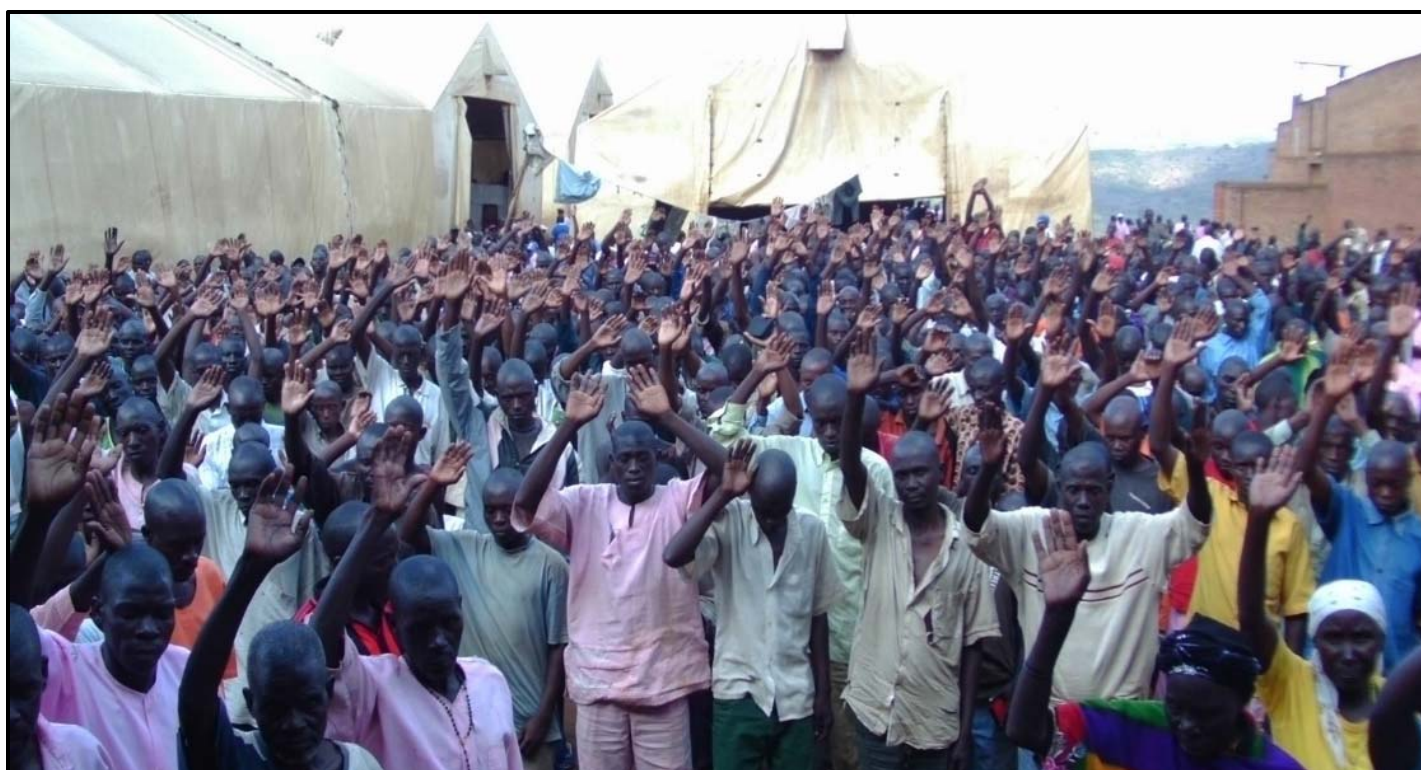

I was able to visit four churches and gave you an update on the last ministry trip to Uganda and Kenya. Sharing is always so much fun for me. Through the PowerPoint presentations, I am able to relay a few of the amazing things the IRM team is able to watch the Holy Spirit do, although adequate words are impossible.



I remember the first time I saw an outpouring of His power in the hearts of the prisoners, bringing them to salvation. My very first prison visit was to Nsinda Prison in 2006 and as I watched the Holy Spirit work, I knew I would never be the same. This wonderful sight has been repeated time and again as He has allowed us to make 299 entrances into prisons in Rwanda, Uganda and Kenya.

The prisoners are so respectful and I enjoy how they welcome me with dancing and singing powerful worship songs. I then have them join me as I sing them a song in their language.

Yesu, arankunda. Yesu arankunda. Yesu arankunda, uko bikwiriye!

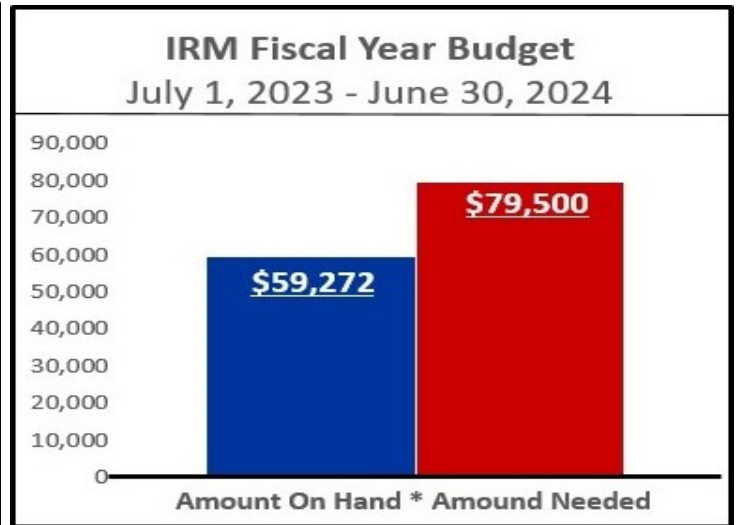
Yes, Jesus loves me. Yes, Jesus loves me. Yes, Jesus loves me, the Bible tells me so!
